Dear Head Track & Field Coach, Athletic Director, or Meet Official

The Mid Penn Track & Field Championship Meet is scheduled for Saturday, May 11, 2024 at the Edwin H. Sponseller Track & Field Complex in Chambersburg.

Meet information is included in this packet. The track & field committee has determined the following structure for the conference meet:

- 1) There will be no separation of events between athletes of AA and AAA schools.
- 2) A girls' champion will be declared based on team points.
- 3) A boys' champion will be declared based on team points.
- 4) Track event participants must meet the qualifying standard. All entries meeting the QS will be accepted. The qualifying standards were adjusted based on 2023 entries.
- 5) Field event participants must meet the qualifying standard. All entries meeting the QS will be accepted. The qualifying standards were adjusted based on 2023 entries.
- 6) Coaches should only enter 3 athletes per individual event. If you have a fourth entry that is in the top 8 on the performance list, contact Dave Roberts and he will permit a 4th entry! This is new!

Entries are due by 11:00PM on Tuesday, May 7, 2024. (Use PA Mile Split)

- 1) A time or distance must be listed for each entry.
- 2) A location must be included for each entry.
- 3) Only outdoor performances from the 2024 season may be used.
- 4) If a time is a hand time, please add 0.24 to the hand time when entering the performance.
- 5) Please include names of relay team members. You may list 6 names.

The 2024 meet is a scratch meet. All athletes meeting the QS are accepted so no one is excluded from the meet. If you have a scratch before meet day, notify Jim Ellingsworth or Dave Roberts via email. Copy Bob Walker (meet director) on the email. You may also scratch an athlete on meet day.

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*There will be no additions after the entry deadline!

A performance list showing all entries will be sent to head coaches on Wednesday, May 8. The seeded meet including heats, lane assignments, flights, et cetera will be sent to head coaches on Thursday, May 9.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The National Federation Rules shall govern the meet except where PIAA exceptions take precedence.
- 2. PIAA modifications will be enforced.
- 3. Bibs will not be used or issued.
- 4. Only spikes of 1/4" or less will be permitted.
- 5. **THIS is a SCRATCH MEET.** *If a scratch is made before Saturday, notify the meet director. Meet day scratches can occur at the clerking area for track events and the venue for field events.
- 6. There will be eight (8) scoring places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1). Medals are given to the top eight (8) places.
- 7. All protests will be resolved by the meet referee.
- 8. Entries are limited to performances from the 2024 outdoor season.
- 9. Any athlete entered in the meet may run on a relay team providing they will not exceed 4 events.
- 10. All events except for relays have a qualifying standard. Please do not enter athletes that have not met the qualifying standard.
- 11. Uniforms must comply with NFHS regulations and PIAA modifications.
- 12. Relay participants must wear similar uniforms.
- 13. Removal of any part of the uniform inside a competitive venue is prohibited.
- 14. The 100m trials, 100m hurdle trials, and 110m hurdles trials will advance the fastest 8 times to the final.
- 15. All other races will be run as a final based on time. The fastest section will be the last section.
- 16. A 3-turn stagger will be used for the 4 x 400m relay.
- 17. Alleys will be used on the first turn for the 800m, 1600m, 3200m, and 4 x 800m events.
- 18. Tape should be used for relay zone markings and at the jumping events. No chalk!
- 19. Starting blocks will be provided. You may use your own starting blocks.
- 20. No sharp objects may be used in the horizontal jumps as marks.
- 21. Competitors must provide their own implements in the throwing events. All implements must be inspected before competition.
- 22. Nine competitors will advance to finals in the throwing events and the horizontal jumps.
- 23. Competitors in the long jump may use an 8-foot or 12-foot take-off board.
- 24. Competitors in the girls' triple jump may use a 24-foot or 30-foot take-off board.
- 25. Competitors in the boys' triple jump may use a 30-foot or 36-foot take-off board.
- 26. There are no minimum measurements marks in the horizontal jumps or the throwing events.
- 27. Starting height in the high jump is the qualifying standard unless the games committee deems it necessary to adjust for poor weather conditions.
- 28. Starting height in the pole vault is the qualifying standard unless the games committee deems it necessary to adjust for poor weather conditions.
- 29. Designated areas will be provided for coaches in all field events.
- 30. Tents at Bus Peters must be placed along the fence. Tents in the stadium may be placed at either end.
- 31. Meet personnel will direct bus parking.
- 32. Headphones, ear buds, air buds may not be worn inside the competitive area.
- 33. Video must be viewed in an area deemed appropriate by the event official.
- 34. Loud music, noise makers, and horns are not permitted in the stadium or Bus Peters throwing venue.
- 35. Frisbees, footballs, soccer balls, et cetera are not permitted in the stadium or Bus Peters throwing venue.

Facilities:

- 1. The track is an 8-lane track.
- 2. Javelin runway is the same as the track surface.
- 3. Trainers will be present. Bring your own supplies.
- 4. Gyms and locker rooms will not be available.
- 5. Concession stand food will be available.
- 6. A limited number of t-shirts will be sold on meet day.

Amenities:

- 1. Meet t-shirts will be sold near the concession stand.
- 2. No packet at this meet! Bibs are not needed.
- 3. Gates open at 7:30AM on meet day.
- 4. Admission prices (as set by the Mid Penn): adults \$8 and students \$4
